 - d. Eventually an app?
- Per Brenda: We need an educational campaign to educate PCC members on advocacy and outreach to policy makers and legislators, how to write a letter, find out who your representative is, attend key events to access policy makers.
- Fern has resigned as Co-Chair of the Men's Health Workgroup and will continue in the role for a little while longer.
