MEMBER HIGHLIGHT

Kayla Whalen – Nurse care coordinator with UPMC Shares a brief presentation to share about the ACS Crucial Catch grant. In response they updated EHR to default to ordering HPV vax at age 9, included an emphasis on cancer prevention, educate providers on recommending the vaccine (same way, same day, and sandwiched with other vaxxes), use reminder calls/text messages/emails, screen savers, updated and reintroduced resources for families, co-branded partnership with ACS.

Data shared:

CCP average 47.3% for HPV completion rates data goes up to 21 yo (Pa 67%; USA 59%)

Completion rates are higher when the vaccine is starter earlier (age 9)

Have increased HPV vax initiation rate for age 9-10 by 10%

Increased HPV vax completion rate by 1-2% for males and females

UPMC has over 300,000 patients total

Kacie Jankoski – great job! Changing the rates to 9yo, the increase in initiation will be transferred to completion rates in the future. Likes magnets as a reminder for patients to come back and complete the vaccine.

William Calo – why is there a big decrease in vaccination status among older age adolescents? Kayla shared that they see the doctor less and receive more pushback from kids as they age

6. New Business & Resource Sharing by Pam Schauer —

The PA Cancer Plan now aligns HPV and Hepatitis B as vaccine preventable strategies (Suzanna Masartis with the Community Liver Alliance). We will align when the messaging makes sense/aligns. We will receive monthly updates re: Hep B vax. Brenda joins both groups, but Pam asked if there are any other liaisons interested in attending both groups.

Final work plan update – Pam shared a slide of the final objective based on workgroup's feedback

Workgroup planning/discussion for 2023 March HPV Awareness Day Multi-state collaboration (MD, DE, WV, VA, DC, OH, PA) – Call to action letter has been completed. Will go to Secretary of Health (Dr. Debra Bogen) to inform her of our efforts. Endorsement letters sent from the President of PA AAP, PA AFP, and chair of PAIC. Katie Noss and Dental subgroup will also share through their newsletters/platform.
