### 4. **Welcome** by Pam Schauer,

Dr. Jonise McDaniel is the new Dental Director for PA DOH. Dr. McDaniel was on camera and introduced herself to the Workgroup.

### 5. **Old Business** by Pam Schauer—

No new updates on Dr. Calo’s HPV ECHO project. First cohort is currently underway, will update when recruitment for cohort 2 launches.

Dr. Mozaffarian gave a recommendation to check out the cancer survivor narratives that were created by Dr. Calo. <https://sites.psu.edu/impstilab/resources> Wonderful tools! Dr. Calo encourage use and they are free for educational use.

Dr. Mozaffarian shared an update on language for vaccinations specifically to HPV around Dental Scope of practice. She has reached out to seek legal guidance and clarification for the HPV Dental Subgroup on the language shared. Hopeful on gaining some clarity for the team...

### 6. **New Business & Open Member Sharing** by Pam Schauer—

PAIC updates (Kayla Knock) COVID-19 vaccination ads are being published in local newspapers this week. Received large grant from CDC to fund local immunization coalitions

to fund lifetime immunizations. Will use billboards, bus campaigns, etc. to increase vaccination uptake. PAIC is also in the process of updating their website.

CDC 2020 NIS-Teen data report is available (Pam Schauer), we HPV vaccination uptake increased from 2019 to 2020, but those gains have been jeopardized and potentially erased by the pandemic.

William Calo – NIS-Teen is “provider verified data”, not self-reported. NIS-Teen 2020 is not representative of the 2020 calendar year (so not a full view of 2020), we won’t see the impact of the pandemic until the NIS-Teen 2021 report.
