- Brenda reviewed the Cancer Plan: final stages and plans to launch at coalition meeting, plan for dissemination. Possibility of translating the plan to Spanish.
- Sean and Nic shared a very interesting video- "Meet the Garcias" available through the Latino Connection. This video is on their site, and can also be found on YouTube. The group had a discussion on doing something like the video, using the Family Tree idea from the initial 'Know Your Roots' flyer project. Thoughts: community events, Pennie tours, etc.

Next Steps

- One pager 'Know Your Roots' flyer will be sent to Latino Connection first, with Sean looking into translation of the flyer into Spanish.
- PA CHC will also be sharing out the flyer, once we have a brief call to review the flyer's educational goals and target audience.
- Next plan to discuss at future meetings: Prostate cancer awareness project, targeting urban YMCA locations and minority men using these sites. We have done a GIS map, used that map along with dashboard stats to focus on several counties as targets, and made a list of those Ys and the counties they are in. We will be getting more demographic info, depending on what the YMCA collects from their sites.
