Meeting Summary and Key Points

September PCC Meeting / Prostate Cancer Awareness Month

- Planning is underway for the September PCC quarterly meeting, which will include a speaker in recognition of Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. Dr. Nyame, vice-chair of the National Prostate Cancer Roundtable, will be our guest speaker. The speaker's PowerPoint presentation is still pending and will be incorporated into the final presentation when received.
- The September 29 prostate cancer awareness event which will be held at the Capitol in Harrisburg, was also briefly discussed.

Annual Provider Update / Call to Action

- The Annual Provider Update/Call to Action has been shared with leadership for review and approval. Once approved, the update will be distributed to Pennsylvania physicians and healthcare provider networks in conjunction with Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. The resource is intended to be useful beyond the initial distribution and can be updated annually as needed.
- Additional dissemination opportunities were identified through professional organizations and medical societies, including family practice and osteopathic organizations.

September Awareness Materials

- Existing materials for the September PCC bulletin include information related to Prostate Cancer Awareness Month, as well as other cancer awareness topics and related news and resources.
- The group will continue coordinating September communications and outreach activities as materials are finalized.

Next Steps

- Finalize the September PCC meeting presentation once the speaker's slides are received.
- Approval of the Annual Provider Update/Call to Action. Prepare the provider update for distribution during or ahead of Prostate Cancer Awareness Month.

- Expand distribution through professional societies and healthcare provider networks.
