### **Meeting Summary and Key Points**

# **Partnerships and Collaborations/Events**

- Details were shared on the upcoming prostate cancer awareness webinar, including the *Save the Date* announcement, registration link, and event materials.
- The event, titled "From Risk Assessment to Action: A Provider Panel on Improving Prostate Cancer Screening in PA," will take place on November 19, 2025, from 2:00–3:00 PM EST.
- This panel represents the key deliverable of the Planning Committee sub-group, developed in collaboration with Pfizer, the Change the Odds Initiative, and ACS CAN.
- **ACS CAN** video featuring *Jim Williams* (produced with Pfizer support) will be included in the upcoming awareness event.
- Ongoing coordination among DOH, ACS, Pfizer, and other partners to advance men's health engagement.

# **Prostate Cancer Screening and Legislation**

- **Prostate Cancer Screening Bill:** Progress limited due to state budget delays; focus shifting to **early 2026** for potential movement.
- Primary emphasis on the **Senate side**, with support from **Sen. Robinson**, who has personal ties to prostate cancer.
- Ongoing collaboration with ZERO and ACS/CAN to strengthen advocacy momentum.
- Broader legislative environment remains slow; need for consistent communication with sponsors to maintain attention.

#### **Health System Updates- Discussion**

- UPMC: Developing a prostate cancer screening clinic for uninsured individuals using recent grant funding.
  - Challenges include operational flow, billing, and clinical coordination.
  - o **Dr. Wu** identified as lead contact; motivation remains strong.
- Jefferson Health: Identified as a model site with a fully operationalized screening pathway.
  - Plan for **UPMC** and **Jefferson** to connect and share process materials to streamline efforts.

# **Next Steps**

- Update Men's Health Workgroup member list, extend invitation for **Jefferson Health** representation.
- Joanne and Greg to connect offline regarding clinical coordination models.
- Continue advocacy strategy for the 2026 legislative session and explore rebranding options.
