1	Donna and Rebekah have been working on meeting with the chairs of the other PCC subcommittees. So far they have met with the health equity, lung, colorectal cancer, and environmental health groups to discuss any areas of potential collaboration in the future. They plan to meet with the other committees over the coming weeks and will provide an update at the next meeting.
2	Donna and Rebekah met with Representative Benninghoff, the chair of the Cancer Caucus. They noted that it was a helpful meeting and Benninghoff asked good questions and discussed if there is any way to get the caucus more active within the legislature and engaged with the PCC. 4	Gary Rathsmill provided an update on HB 78 (erasing medical debt). The bill has accumulated more co-sponsors. Governor Shapiro included \$4 million in his budget proposal. The bill is being discussed during the budget hearings.
