1	All members are requested to fill out the PCC Annual Stakeholder Survey by July 15. This survey is very important for the PCC's strategic planning process.
2	The July 4 meeting will be rescheduled to July 11 to avoid the July 4 holiday. Please keep an eye out for an updated meeting invite from Rebekah.

4	Donna shared that the Biomarker bill (HB 1754) passed unanimously out of the House Insurance Committee this past Monday and will likely pass out of the House next Monday. It will then go to the Senate.
5	<p>Rebekah shared that two other bills have passed out of committee: Senator Vogel's Telemedicine Bill (SB 739) passed out of the House Insurance Committee and Senator Judy Ward's Pharmacy Benefit Manager Bill (SB 1000) passed out of the Senate Health & Human Services Committee.</p> <p>Rebekah shared a helpful article published by the Penn Capital Star on the Pharmacy Benefit Manager issue and SB 1000.</p>
6	Another bill update that may be of interest to the group: HB 2234 (Representative Kim) passed out of the House this week. This bill would create a pilot program around a Medicaid wrap-around subsidy. The bill is being led by PHAN. More info here .
7	<p>Donna provided an update on her meeting with Representative Benninghoff, the chair of the Cancer Caucus.</p> <p>There was discussion around inviting Representative Benninghoff to join a future PCC Policy meeting and sending out the PCC flyer to the full legislature. The group wants to invite legislators to the September 12 PCC Annual Meeting to provide legislators with more context/information about the PCC and all the important work the subcommittees are doing. Donna and Rebekah will follow up on this for the next meeting.</p>
