ID	Discussion
1	State Legislative updates – Copay accumulator HB 2226 and amendments were passed out of the House Insurance Committee along party lines. The All Copays Count Coalition opposed the amendments due to access limitations they would create for patients. Colorectal cancer screening HB 1123 was unanimously passed out of the Senate Banking & Insurance Committee. It needs a full Senate vote before going to the House on concurrence. The PA State Budget is expected to pass toward the end of July. We discussed the importance of screening funds within the state budget and the possibility of advocating for a proactive increase early in 2027.
2	Federal Legislative updates – Clinical Trials Modernization Act is pending. This legislation would remove barriers for marginalized populations to participate in clinical trials. ACS CAN will be holding a policy forum on this and research funding topics in the Fall.
