Disparate Populations to Address (why this population is or should be a priority)

- People with cancer, or living beyond cancer, in PA from underserved groups. This includes those in rural areas, Black and/or Latinx individuals, people whose primary language is Spanish, ~~and~~ the Amish, and gender-nonconforming individuals or those who identify as LGBTQ+.

Approaches Planned to Address this Disparate Population Group

- survivorship resources - identify resources accessible to individuals in the above groups, with consideration to people with limited incomes or low technology access.
- physical activity - develop programming for targeted groups, eg Spanish-speaking or LGBTQ+.
- navigation - explore collaboration opportunities to address health equity issues & overcome barriers

Existing Health Equity Approaches to Address this Disparate Population Group (describe by organization)

- YMCA Tours are covering communities across PA, bringing screening & resources.
- Livestrong at YMCA online physical activity sessions are accessible to people unable to attend in-person programs, eg in rural communities at a distance from live sessions.
