## 4 Discussion

2	American Childhood Cancer Organization: Jessica presented background about ACCO (see		
	attached slides), with emphasis on inclusion of childhood cancer in state cancer control plans (most		
	effective with workgroup support - see attached tip sheet).		
3	ReVital Cancer Rehabilitation: Kelsey presented on the importance of cancer rehabilitation in		
	addressing side effects of cancer and its treatment.		
4	Workgroup strategies: Stefanie reviewed the workgroup's priority strategies, which are to:		
	Support health systems in the development and implementation of survivorship programs		
	by increasing access to community resources for healthcare providers and people living with cancer;		
	Through member organizations, provide physical activity programming to Pennsylvanians		
	aged 18+ and living with or beyond a cancer diagnosis, to reach at least the recommended		
	150 minutes per week of moderate-intensity physical activity, by 2023;		
	<ul> <li>Collaborate with patient navigation programs to address barriers to access to care and</li> </ul>		
	resources commonly experienced by people with cancer; and		
	Expand our membership to add new perspectives and insights.		
	The group discussed potential future updates to these strategies including childhood cancer, rehab and quality of life, food insecurity, and secondary cancer screening. The group also expressed interest in learning more about the direction of the new state cancer control plan and its priorities, to help inform workgroup direction. The group discussed focus areas of other PCC workgroups such as lung health and men's health. Bob recommended connecting with "Man Up to Cancer" and their Facebook group as a way to increase participation in the workgroup/PCC.		
5	Updates/closing: The June PCC meeting was canceled and the September meeting was rescheduled		
	from 9/21 to 9/14. Amy updated the workgroup on Google document resources (member listing and
